## What is a CCI?


**CCI** A Comprehensive Cancer Infrastructure should also include public functions such as public health, screening, primary and community care, and population cancer registries.

## CCN

**Comprehensive Cancer Networks\*** serve a defined population and consist of: **Comprehensive Cancer Centres (CCC) Clinical Cancer Centres, individual cancer clinics Research Institutes and Universities** Units of General Hospitals. Diagnostic units etc.




